Important! Read carefully, Fill in All Blanks, Send Photographs

New Department of Transportation (DOT) regulations are now being enforced in many states. It is only a matter of time until they will be enforced in all states, resulting in many bobtails in use today becoming illegal. DOT regulations require that all dealers have in their possession a copy of the original Manufacturer's Data Report for each bobtail. If the Manufacturer's Data Report has been lost and the company that built the tank is no longer in business, it may be impossible to obtain a duplicate copy. A duplicate can be obtained if the tank has a "National Board" number. However, many tank manufacturers did not use a National Board number. DOT regulations also require that the tank have an MC-330 or MC-331 plate. This is a different plate from the ASME plate and is a stainless steel plate located on the right side of the tank, near the front head seam. These two items are very important! We must know if you have a data report. If not, does the tank have a "National Board" number? (This is a different number from the serial number.) We also must know if the tank has the stainless steel plate with the words "MC-331". We no longer are able to trade for MC-330 tanks. Thank you.
